Thank you for your interest in our annual Summer Camp Graduation in Tecate, Mexico. This document is intended to give you the information you need to prepare for this event and let you have the best day possible.

Before You Go

- ✓ **Documentation:** U.S. citizens are required to have a U.S. passport or passport cards. Senti card and Global Entry card are also accepted.
- ✓ **Mexican Auto Insurance:** Check with your insurance carrier, some offer coverage in Mexico. If not, you can purchase insurance online, BEFORE the build with Bajabound, our proud partner. Visit the Bajabound website at www.bajabound.com.
- ✓ **Supplies:** Bring sunscreen, hat, glasses, snacks and plenty of water. Other suggested supplies: handy wipes, hand sanitizer, lip balm, sandals or flip-flops welcomed, summer clothing, camera and change of clothes if you plan on getting wet! Do not bring anything you can't afford to lose.
- ✓ **Safety:** Your safety is very important to us. Corazón staff and board members will be present at the site to provide detailed instructions. Please look at the safety section on our website for more information.
- ✓ **Carpool:** Please carpool to keep the cars to a minimum so the caravan is manageable.
- ✓ **Fill the tank** - Please fill up before leaving the U.S.

Project Day Schedule

Meet at 6:30 AM - at the [Terra Nova Plaza parking lot in front of Von's](#) in Chula Vista. The address for the plaza is 360 E. H Street, Chula Vista, CA 91910. Take the 805 to the H Street east exit, make a right upon exiting and the shopping center/parking lot is on the right.

Review & Departure: 6:30 – 6:40AM: A brief meeting about the caravan procedures and driving instructions will take place, as well as a brief project review.

The Caravan to Mexico: The caravan will stay together and wait for any cars that are instructed to go through secondary inspection.

Arrival at Site 8:30AM: A schedule and volunteer duties will be provided at the campgrounds upon arrival.

Departure Approximately 3:00PM: You will receive instructions at lunchtime from your Trip Coordinator. U.S. Passports are required to cross the border.
